
Dear BUHSD Parents, Community, and Staff,

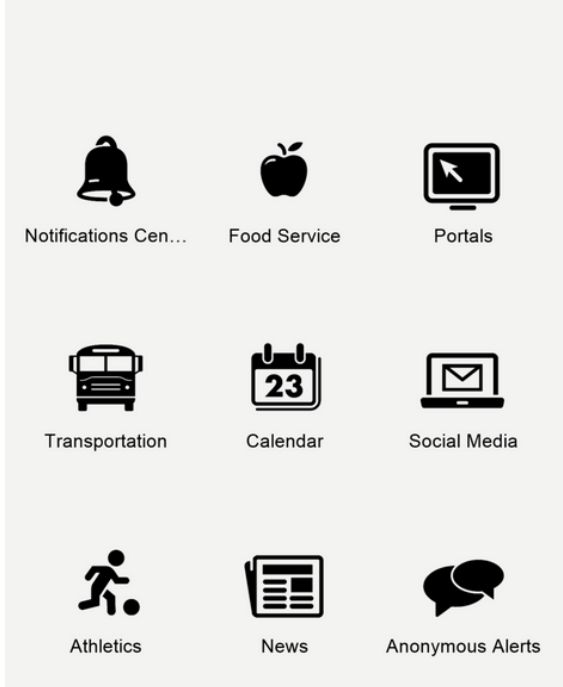
Student & Staff News

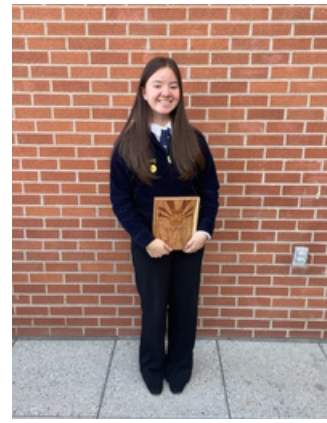
