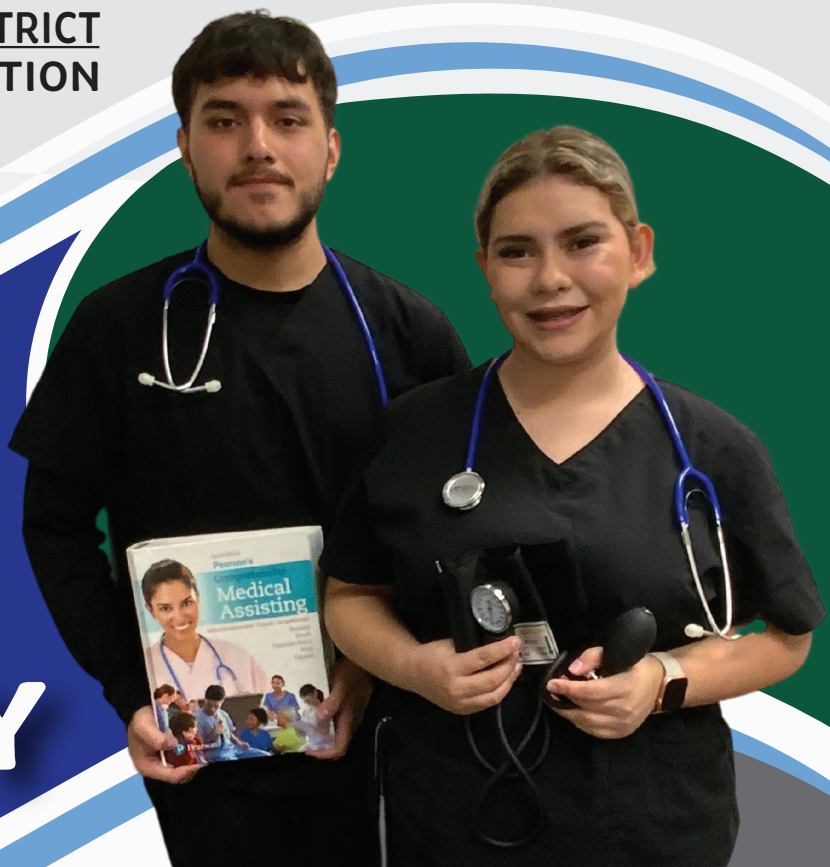

Medical Assisting Program Sequence

The Medical Assisting Services program includes instruction in basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, medical law and ethics, patient psychology and communications, medical office procedures, and clinical diagnostic, examination, testing, and treatment procedures.

- Perform clinical skills: electrocardiograms, vision testing, audiometry, administer medications, ear lavage, pulse oximetry and spirometry and peak flow testing
