(Note: If your student still has their laptop from last year – we are asking for you to bring that device in ASAP this week to our tech center to drop off so important updates can be made prior to this distribution next week.)

We will accomplish this distribution in a **drive through** manner – included is a map that details the route you will take. Pickup will take place in front of our tech center, where students will receive their laptop, login directions, and a packet of registration materials including directions for parents to complete.

It is critical for students to login to the laptop prior to leaving campus as students will not be able to access them at your home without this critical step. Returning students will need their student ID and last password used and new students will need their student ID and will use the password Change.Me in order to log in. Specific detailed instructions will be included when students receive their laptop.

Student schedules will not be finalized until after students/parents have selected Option A (distance learning) or B (online learning), so please be patient as school staff will be adjusting schedules as quickly as possible to meet the needs of all students.
