To improve our communication with our stakeholders, we are in the process of having a Buckeye Union High School District App created that will help us to connect with every parent, student, community member, and staff member who chooses to download our app to their mobile device. Once completed, the app will be available on both Apple and Android and will allow us to communicate directly to all individuals who desire to receive our communications. Just like other apps that exist today, when we use our app to communicate with stakeholders, those stakeholders will have a notification on their phone and will be able to quickly read any message sent to them from wherever they are. Another benefit of having a district app is being able to quickly share communications and information beyond just messages to our stakeholders. Our app will have information contained on our website loaded to the app. Things like bell schedules, athletic calendars, social media posts, letters from the superintendent, and other communications will also be available on your mobile device very soon. We are hoping to be able to have our app ready to roll out in early October. We will let everyone know once it is available to be added to your mobile devices.
